INTRODUCTION

THE ULTIMATE

We've named it for good reason. URC is a high-profile, officially sanctioned (by Motorsport UK) touring car-focussed championship hitting the UK in 2025, with a full investment and strategy plan built for stability and longevity, delivered at a clublevel cost for entrants.

Joining the URC means joining a friendly, welcoming and forwardthinking family of racers, dedicated to competition and supported by an experienced team in the Time Attack Organisation. We're a 35-strong professional team who for two decades have been delivering high profile automotive events around the UK. Racing in the URC means joining an existing ecosystem of race series and car shows. Events uniquely combines multiple ontrack race series with an offtrack, themed and curated car show, bringing together the best of both worlds and attracting a larger, more relevant and wider audience demographic than most race series can hope to achieve. Competing in the URC means being part of a bigger whole, and presents exciting opportunities for both drivers and sponsors We have every aspect of the championship covered: not just races at the best tracks in the UK, but a full package of managed regulations, support, logistics, marketing and promotion.

Sharing the track with URC will be the well-established UK Time Attack Championship (featuring some of the most powerful racing machinery in the UK), the wildly successful Racing Hondas Championship and also other ontrack excitement such as the Drift Pro Championship and spectator driving experiences.

AN EPIC LEGACY

Touring cars have always been the ultimate aspirational racing machines: the literal link between the cars we all drive on the road and the visceral thrill of motorsport – and the UK in particular has had a long love affair with them.

There's a levelling spirit, where instead of unaffordable supercars or irrelevant single seaters we can see our own cars transformed into racing beasts. Touring cars' popularity exploded in the 1960s with the birth of the British Saloon Car Championship, then hitting heady heights in the '70s when American muscle cars butted up against Escorts, Anglias and Imps while mosquito Minis buzzed around them.

Our raceday car shows already attract up to 10,000 people, mostly comprising the highly sought-after 18-35 year-old market. We surveyed 2,500 attendees across three events in 2024 to get their awareness of touring cars as a sport. Just 12% had heard of it, proving there's a completely fresh market who are just not engaging with current motorsport series.

So we don't need to create a new audience: we've got one ready to go. They're already at our events. URC will be evolving and involving a completely new generation of fans who are ignored by mainstream motorsport. We're also working on building up the attendance numbers even more. This year we're broadening out our events even wider, creating a halo Club Of Clubs to encourage people to attend more than one event, pushing out increased support for car clubs to help with presentation and delivering yet more off-track entertainment options.

Following the record-breaking investment and success in our sister Racing Hondas Championship last year – where Tegiwa bought the entry fees for the entire grid and provided them at no charge in a deal never seen before in racing – the very same initiative will be repeated in URC with a similar investment by the acclaimed motorsports parts supplier.

Tegiwa will provide 32 full-season entries at no charge to successful teams that apply to them to take up the offer (note that URC drivers will still need a Club Time Attack membership at £80 for the year). This means that any driver wishing to compete for free can apply using a simple online form, direct to Tegiwa by 28th February 2025. Tegiwa will then assess viability and announce their final decisions in early March.

YOUR ENGAGEMENT

SEVEN ROUNDS

A URC round is about more than just racing: every round is a celebration of car culture. The seven one-day meetings mean a lower cost for teams while delivering plenty of track time and high-octane racing. URC features a maximum 32 cars on the grid, although some rounds are able to expand where track licences allow.

Entrants' cars will be performance-balanced to keep the racing close: this will be managed by the experts at Race Technology (who also manage SRO championships).





Each session will feature the full TSL timing package, delivering a complete set of analytics data.

There will be championship podium presentations at each round and end of season trophies. URC will have its own dedicated space in the paddock at each track along with extensive branding. There is also modestly priced pre-event testing available, organised by the circuits.

RACE AT THE BEST CIRCUITS

The inaugural year of Ultimate Racing Championship comprises pre-season testing and seven rounds, held on the best tracks all round the UK: it's a truly national championship.

From the famous sweeps of Donington Park and the flat-out blasts of Snetterton to the bullrings of Knockhill and Brands Hatch Indy, with URC you get to race on the cream of the UK's circuits. Each event also comprises a major off-track car show*, with spectator sizes between 6-10,000.

All events held on Motorsport Vision circuits (MSV) are given a major Promoted status, meaning we add the might of MSV to our media promotion programme. It also reinforces that our events draw some of the biggest crowds in the UK outside only the BTCC and BSB. The associated car shows are well established on the car scene calendar as annual highlights of the year, attracting not just a passionate local crowd but also special appearances from wellknown builders and tuners.

AROUND THE UK



REGULATIONS FOR RACING

URC has its own unique sporting and technical rule book – there's no requirement to follow any other regulations or log-booking. We want to concentrate on what you can deliver on track, rather than what you can't do off it.

There are no mandatory control parts or consumables enforced. The use of pump or race fuel is a choice for teams. You can use non OEM-supplied vehicle parts on a like-for-like basis without the need to maintain a factory type specification. There is Balance of Performance, defined by clear parameters of power, weight, boost and rideheight. There will be a pre-season dyno check, weigh and seal carried out at Tegiwa at no cost to teams.

Transparent BoP adjustments will be made, clearly communicated and delivered through the season to ensure close racing. Live data for monitoring BoP will be provided by industry experts Race Technology. Data-logging equipment is hired race-by-race and placed in each car, with data transmitted back live from the race using GSM.

NOT MEETING ROOMS

ROLL ON

URC is keeping the technical aspects as open as possible to make entering the championship as easy as possible. There are no overly-complex or expensive homologation requirements beyond the top-level specification. However strict BoP monitoring and the use of control

tyres for URC are the levellers.

In direct partnership with Hankook Motorsport in Germany, URC tyres are provided pre-event, with one slick and wet option for all teams. Tyre budgets are controlled, with a maximum of 60 slick tyres to be used across a season but no restriction on wets. New to the UK, the rubber is a race-proven compound used in many international series such as TCR Italy. Suppliers Hankook Motorsport already exclusively supply the WRC, Formula E and DTM, as well as many other teams competing in domestic touring cars series around the world, the NLS and multiple endurance races. Teams will fit tyres prior to an event, with spares available at each event for any emergency supply. On-site fitting will be provided by Tegiwa in such cases (at no charge) and an official Hankook Tyre Performance Engineer will be at each race meeting to assist teams in optimising tyre use.

There will be colabs on social channels and we'll be forming partnerships in the run-up to the championship's opening round, including programmes with our major commercial partners.

THINK WE'RE NEW TO RACING?

We know how to launch and nurture brand new products. Two decades ago we brought Time Attack and Drift over from Japan and introduced them into the UK for the first time, while localising them for our country.

Our team launched Racing Hondas in 2023, and Autosport reported that last year we had the highest increase in grid numbers of any UK championship: up 175%.

DRIFT PROE CHAMPIONSHIP

In 2024 Racing Hondas had the highest increase in grid numbers of any UK Championship: up 175% We currently manage over 100 registered drivers in Time Attack, 60 in Racing Hondas and 40 for Drift Pro. Our package is a proven multi-faceted offering which provides URC with undeniable potential: we are reinventing touring cars as a sport, not simply running a new championship.

We also already have experience of running touring cars within our events. As a club we hosted two seasons of TCR UK races in 2021-22, where grids went from 8-10 cars a race to 28 – widely regarded as when TCR UK in the UK was at its strongest. Our unique events provided the backdrop for this style of racing to gather momentum.
